

## **OBC Policy #6**

### **Use of Club Van**

The OBC Van can be used by Members for approved Club activities, such as race support, Touring Events support, Rideau Lakes Tour. The Racing and Youth Programs will have first priority to populate the van calendar, held by the OBC Admin, at the start of each season. After June 1 of each year, use is first come first served.

Coordination of maintenance of the van will fall to the Club Administrator, with assistance from the Youth and Racing Events directors.

The OBC may borrow a trailer from a Club member,

The OBC may also rent a trailer from a Rental Agency.

Unless the trailer is a rental unit, the owner of the trailer must have insurance for damage to the trailer. The owner of a loaned trailer must sign an agreement acknowledging that the Club is not responsible for any damage to the trailer whether insured or not. In other words, it is being loaned to the Club at the owner's risk. For a borrowed trailer, the owner of the trailer must be the driver of the van while it is towing the trailer. For a rental trailer, the Club will abide by the terms of the rental agreement regarding the use, operation and driver(s) of the van pulling the trailer.

For a borrowed trailer, the owner of the trailer / driver of the van must provide drivers licence information to the OBC and have the trailer ownership papers in his/her possession while towing the trailer with the van.
